RE: THE LATE MS DULCIE SEPTEMBER

We act for the family of the late Dulcie September. We write to request your assistance in the following circumstances:

- On behalf of the family we have made an access to information request to your department and the Paris embassy in terms of the Promotion of Access to Information Act seeking any material or correspondence and reports pertaining to Dulcie September that passed between the erstwhile Department of Foreign Affairs and the SA Embassy in Paris. A copy of our original application is attached for easy reference;
- 2. Your department acknowledged receipt and the necessary payments were made. Mr Ravhengani confirmed telephonically that the request was receiving attention.
- 3. By way of email dated 1 November 2019 Mr Tshirado forwarded a letter from Information Officer Mr Mahoai dated 25 October advising that our request for information had been transferred in terms of Section 20(1)(b) of the Act to the Department of State Security. Mr Mahoai appeared to be of the opinion that this 1998 event which took place at the height of the Apartheid state's disregard for the Rule of Law was "more closely connected with the functions of that department";
 - 4. Mr Caiphus Ravhengani thereafter on 6 November sent us an email apologising for the delay advised that after consultation with his superior "The department is busy with your request the directorate responsible with your request is busy finalizing your request. You will get respond soon. Apologies for the inconvenience."

We have since then heard nothing further from either DIRCO or from State Security and both have failed to comply with the times provided for in the statute and granted no access and given no reasons for their inactivity. We are concerned that our clients may be getting the unnecessary run around in regard to these issues. We have now reached the stage where it may become necessary for us to lodge an internal appeal and in the absence of a satisfactory response, thereafter litigation. Our clients would prefer to avoid litigation.

We are of the view that the Ministry too would prefer that this be resolved amicably especially as it does not relate to actions taken by the democratic state and we are thus asking that you investigate this matter and expedite our clients access to the requested documents rather than us being compelled to lodge an appeal or to litigate in the New Year.

We look forward to hearing from you.
