RE: JUDICIAL COMMISSION OF INQUIRY TO INQUIRE INTO ALLEGATIONS REGARDING EFFORTS OR ATTEMPTS HAVING BEEN MADE TO STOP THE INVESTIGATIONS

1. We write to you on behalf of the Commission of Inquiry into the stopped TRC cases.
2. We have communicated with several individuals who may have in their possession information which may assist in the determination of the Terms of Reference ("TOR").
3. Adv Anton Ackermann SC, who has some of the pertinent information has provided us with a statement. He is a former Special Director of Public Prosecutions in the Office of the National Director of Public Prosecutions ("NDPP").
4. In terms of section 13(1)(c) of the National Prosecuting Act, No. 32 of 1998 ("the Act"), he was appointed by President TM Mbeki, under a Presidential



Proclamation dated 24 March 2003, to head the Priority Crimes Litigation Unit ("PCLU"), located at the head office of the National Prosecuting Authority ("NPA").

5. He served as head of the PCLU from 2003 to 2013, when he retired.
6. He has requested the Commission to secure or subpoena the following documents and items of evidence:
 - 6.1 A copy of the fabricated note referred to in paragraph 10 of his affidavit.
 - 6.2 Relevant documents, including reports and correspondence, from the person commissioned to investigate the hacking of my computer in respect of the fabricated note.
 - 6.3 Report on the costs expended for the services of the investigator.
7. We attach a copy of the affidavit.
8. Please assist in locating the above documents and furnish them to us as soon as possible.
9. Due to the strict timelines under which we operate please let us have the documents within 7 days of this letter.
