

INVITATION TO VICTIMS AND INTERESTED PARTIES TO MAKE REPRESENTATIONS REGARDING CERTAIN PARDON MATTERS

The President is considering the applications mentioned in the Schedule, who have been recommended for pardon by the Reference Group and who are relying on a political motive and/or political objective for which they seek a pardon. Within the context of the national reconciliation and unity objectives for which special dispensation process of 2007, the President must make a final decision on whether to grant or refuse a pardon to these applicants. The Department of Justice and Constitutional Development writes the victims of offences committed by the applicants for pardon and any parties with a direct or substantial interest in the applications for pardon under consideration by the President in terms of the special dispensation process of 2007, to Any person or party who wishes to make representations to the Presidency must notify the Secretariat	In writing within 30 days of this publication, The Secretariat will respond to any communication received within 30 days thereafter such party will have a period of 30 days to lodge a detailed and substantiated written request for pardon.
