



MEDIA STATEMENT: TRC Cases Inquiry to start hearings on 10 November 2025

Tuesday, 16 September 2025 - The Judicial Commission of Inquiry into Allegations Regarding Efforts or Attempts to Stop the Investigation or Prosecution of Truth and Reconciliation Commission Cases (TRC Cases Inquiry), calls on all interested and affected parties to file witness statements, memoranda, reports and any other relevant documentation and evidence by Friday, 10 October 2025.

The Chairperson of the Inquiry, former Constitutional Court judge, Justice Sisi Khampepe, and her two co-commissioners, retired Northern Cape Judge President Diale Kgomo and Advocate Andrea Gabriel SC, agreed that, in order to hear oral testimony from Monday, 10 November 2025, the four weeks (from now until the 10th of October), would be sufficient time to allow those with a direct interest in the work of the Inquiry and with relevant information that can advance the Inquiry's Terms of Reference, to make submissions.
